Scenic Valley Swimming Pool provides safe, clean and friendly swimming accommodations to residents of Cochrane, Buffalo City, Belvidere and the surrounding areas.

Daily Hours:

- 1:00-8:00 p.m.

- 3:00-3:30 p.m.
- 5:30-6:00 p.m.

Lap Swim:

- 6:30-8:30 a.m. (T&TH)
- 7:30-8:30 a.m. (M-F)
- 5:30-6:00 p.m.

Morning Water Aerobics and Lap Swim:

- 6:30-7:30 a.m. (T&TH)
- 7:30-8:30 a.m. (M-F)

Membership and Admission Fees

Daily Rate:

- \$3.00 per person
- \$5.00 Family Sundays (Your immediate family can swim all day for only \$5.00)

Membership Fees:

- Family Resident = \$85
- Family Non-Resident = \$110
- Single Resident = \$50
- Single Non-Resident = \$60

Swimming Lesson Sessions:

Levels 1-6 are scheduled Monday-Thursday with Fridays being make-up days. Children must be 4 years old or older to enroll.

- Session 1: June 8-25
- Session 2: July 6-23

- 9:30-10:00 a.m. - Level 5
- 10:00-10:30 a.m. - Level 4
- 10:30-11:00 a.m. - Level 3

- 11:30-12:00 p.m. - Level 1

Swimming Lesson Rates:

- Members-\$10.00 each with a maximum of \$30.00 per family
- Non-Members-\$30.00 each

How can I register?:

Registration forms are available at the Scenic Valley Swimming Pool starting June 1. Complete the swimming lesson registration form and submit at front desk with your payment. Registration is limited, so sign up early. Swimming lessons must be paid in full by June 5 for Session 1 and by July 3 for Session 2.

Directions as Easy as 1, 2, 3:

1. From Highway 35, turn onto 5th Street
2. Turn left onto Main Street
3. Turn right onto 4th Street/Eikamp Street

Scenic Valley Swimming Pool Rules:

- Children ages 10 and under MUST be accompanied by an adult unless they have received permission from the lifeguards. Permission will be granted when they can show responsibility, respect, and swimming skills.
- During ALL breaks, EVERYONE must leave the pool deck.
- This is the only way our lifeguards can take a full break.
- Our guards need this break to rejuvenate for the next session.
- Adults will be allowed to lap swim from 5:30-6:00.

- NO food, gum, or pop on pool deck.
- NO Running allowed.
- Listen to the Lifeguards.
- Our lifeguard's main responsibility is safety.
- Misbehavior will not be tolerated.
- Toys in the pool will be allowed only if approved.
- The quantity and type of toys allowed in the pool is up to the lifeguard's discretion.
- NO floatable devices, except for arm floaties.
- Everyone must sign in EVERY day.
- Staff ONLY in the lifeguard room.
- Shower before swimming.
- Only properly attired swimmers will be allowed to swim.
- Infants must wear swim diapers.
- No loitering.
- No dunking or horseplay.
- No hanging on the ropes or diving boards.
- No swearing or other rough language.
