

VOTING BY ABSENTEE BALLOT
SPRING ELECTION, April 6, 2021
Supreme Court Justice, Court of Appeals Dist. 3, School Boards & Town Board

Any qualified elector who is unable or unwilling to appear at the polling place on Election Day may request to vote an absentee ballot. A qualified elector is any U.S. citizen, who will be 18 years of age or older on Election Day, who has resided in the ward or municipality for at least 28 consecutive days before an election. The elector must also be registered in order to receive an absentee ballot (Contact clerk to register.) Proof of identification must be provided.

REQUEST FOR AN ABSENTEE BALLOT IN WRITING OR THROUGH MyVote.wi.gov.

Requests can be sent to the town clerk via **email** at belvidereclerk@cctcoop.com. Your **written** request must list your voting address within the municipality where you wish to vote, the address where the absentee ballot will be sent (if different), a copy of your I.D., and your signature. Requests may be made **in person**. (see contact information below.) Requests may be made through **MyVote.wi.gov** and the ballot will be sent within 48 hours. The deadline for making an application to receive an absentee by mail is 5:00 p.m. April 1, 2021.

NOTE: Special absentee voting application provisions apply to electors who are indefinitely confined to home or care facility, are in the military, hospitalized, or serving as a sequestered juror. If this applies to you, contact the municipal clerk regarding deadlines for requesting and submitting an absentee ballot.

IN PERSON ABSENTEE VOTING

You may request to vote in the clerk's office between March 16, 2021 and April 2, 2021 until 5 pm.

There will be no absentee voting on April 5, 2021.

The clerk will deliver any absentee ballots to the polling place on April 6, 2021.
Any absentee ballots received after the polls close will not be counted.
