RESOLUTION NO. 2021-1

For Town Electors to Authorize the Town Board to Exceed State Spending Limits on Town Roads in 2022

WHEREAS, Wisconsin State Statutes limit towns from spending more than \$5,000 per mile on road during the course of a calendar year; and

WHEREAS, this limit includes the cost of all aspects of road repair and maintenance, including snowplowing, filling potholes, and re-surfacing; and


WHEREAS, the Town of Belvidere has 30.82 miles of road, which limits the spending on its roads to no more than \$154,100 per year; and

WHEREAS, the State Statute hasn't been updated in decades to account for inflation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the residents of the Town of Belvidere do hereby authorize the Belvidere Town Board to spend up to \$350,000 on Town roads in calendar year 2022, if the Town Board believes it is in the best interest of the Town to do so.

Adopted this 16th day of November, 2021 by Town of Belvidere electors at the Town Special Meeting by a vote of 3 (ayes) to 0 (nays), with 0 abstaining.


